Introduction

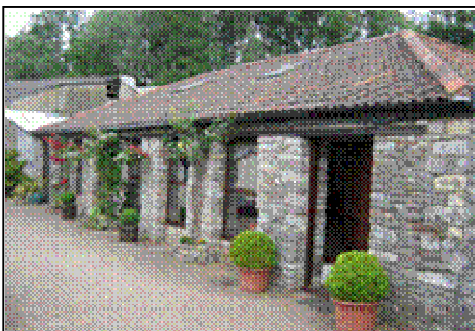
A unique, unforgettable day you will be given the opportunity to drive some of the world's meanest military vehicles at one of the UK's best purpose-built tank driving circuits.

Adventure out and experience the difference between an Armoured Personnel Carrier, a robust 15 ton vehicle, the Ferret Scout Car, with a 4.2 litre 6 cylinder Rolls Royce engine, a 17-ton Self-Propelled Abbot Gun, the Snow cat, which can operate on snow, marshes or on soft desert sand, or the Stalwart, an amphibious 5 ton capacity cargo truck. Bristol Location

ACF Hospitality's Headquarters are nestled at the foot of the Mendip Hills in amongst 300 scenic acres of land offering some of the best facilities in the UK for activities and teambuilding days. The site is a 25-minute drive from Bristol City Centre and only 5 minutes from Bristol International Airport with easy access from the M4 and M5. ACF is also on a convenient route from South Wales.



Itinerary

08.30am Guests arrive at the ACF site and meet in the 17th Century function room for refreshments and a brief on the days events.

09.00am Then it's up to site to start your four hour Military fest!! Trained instructors will spend time teaching you how to operate the vehicles over a variety of challenging terrains.

13.00pm To finish the morning, refreshments will be served in the comfort of our 17th Century function room, where guests will be presented with their certificate.

ARMOURED PERSONNEL CARRIER FV432

The FV432 Armoured Personnel Carrier is designed to carry troops into battle. This robust vehicle weighs 15 tons and is powered by an 8 litre Rolls Royce engine. The APC is a tracked vehicle with skid steering making it easy and fun to drive. Manoeuvre our APC around our challenging off road course where you will encounter a number of serious dips and ditches.



STALWART 6 WHEEL DRIVE

The Stalwart FV623 is an amphibious all terrain vehicle. This remarkable machine can speed across the most demanding terrain and has the ability to travel through high water. This exciting vehicle provides a thrilling and fun drive for all guests.



SNOWCAT

The Snowcat is an articulated tracked vehicle that is used by the military for transporting troops over snow. This is a fun vehicle to manoeuvre through a variety of obstacles.



SCOUT CAR

Used as a light reconnaissance vehicle, this Daimler Ferret Scout Car remains one of the most successful British military vehicles to date. It has a 4.2 litre 6 cylinder Rolls Royce engine. Made for over 40 years until the mid 90s.



ABBOT

The Abbot is a 17-ton Self-Propelled Gun with capabilities of shooting over 10 miles. It was designed to be a mobile gun to carry troops into battle. The automatic transmission in the 6 litre Rolls Royce K60 with 240H, makes this vehicle fascinating to drive on an off road track.

Guidelines

TIMINGS: Your experience starts at 8.30am and end at around 1.00pm. Your instructor will determine the length of each session based on simple rules set out in the briefing.

NUMBERS ON THE DAY: There will be a maximum of six people per instructor. There may be other activities taking place on the same day.

SPECTATORS: We allow you to bring 1 spectator free of charge to watch you participate in your selected experience. A nominal fee of £10 is charged for every spectator thereafter. The fee applies to both adults and children. When booking your date please inform the staff you wish to bring other people. Spectators are required to comply with our terms, conditions and expectations of conduct. Any spectators deemed under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted on site.

DRESS CODE: Our recommendation for clothing is something loose fitting and comfortable. Ladies should wear trousers. Although it is unlikely you will get very muddy, we recommend you wear something that you don't mind getting dirty. Footwear should be sturdy and flat. Boots, sensible shoes or trainers are ideal. In the colder months ACF recommend additional clothing such as hats, scarves and gloves.

SAFETY GUIDELINGS: We recommend that the maximum height for Military Manoeuvres Day, is 6'5". The maximum weight is 18 stone. Instructors decision is final. A full driving license is required*

Booking Conditions

1. CANCELLATION/ POSTPONEMENT BY THE CLIENT: Once you have had your place confirmed on a Military Manoeuvres Day, ACF Hospitality will require a 28 days notice in order to change or cancel your place on the day and an administration fee of £25 will be charged.

2. LIABILITY: Neither the proprietors of ACF Hospitality Ltd nor their servants or agents accept liability for any personal injury, loss, or damage of any kind sustained by a guest or spectator whilst taking part in or spectating at an activity organised by ACF Hospitality Ltd.

3. IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY: ACF Hospitality staff reserves the right to refuse a client access to the vehicles on the day should they suspect the participant to be under the influence of alcohol or recreational drugs.

4. CANCELLATION BY ACF HOSPITALITY LTD: We shall make every reasonable effort to stage the event but the right to cancel is reserved by us. If we are obliged to cancel we shall not give less than 24 hours notice. We shall try to offer a suitable alternative date but if an alternative date cannot be agreed then a full refund on your voucher will be given. We shall have no further liability.

5. ACTIVITY UNABLE TO TAKE PLACE: Should our clients arrive intending to take part in an agreed activity and that activity is unable to take place due to causes outside our control, we shall offer an alternative date but if an alternative date cannot be agreed then a full refund on your voucher will be given. We shall have no further liability.

6. EQUIPMENT: All equipment at ACF Hospitality Ltd is maintained to a high standard; however, in the unlikely event that any equipment fails an alternative vehicle will be used.

7. SAFETY STATEMENTS: A safety statement will be issued on the day which must be read and signed before participation.

8. RESTRICTIONS: *All participants must hold a full driving license. All participants must be aged 18 and over and be of reasonable fitness. Any medical conditions should be brought to our attention prior to the event.

9. CHILDREN AND ANIMALS: No animals are allowed on site and children under the age of 13 must be supervised by a non participating adult.
